

# STONE TEMPLE 8

**SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 27<sup>TH</sup>, 2008**

This race will be run on the new IMBA designed single track trails at Wyoming's Curt Gowdy State Park. Racers will compete for eight hours on an approximately 8.5 mile loop, in teams and as individuals. The start/finish is will be located at the Aspen Grove Trailhead Parking Area. **Race Start: 9:30 AM.**

## **Entry Fees:** Cost per rider:

\$20 per Junior Rider before September 23, 2008

\$50 per adult rider before September 23, 2008

\$60 per adult rider after September 23, 2008 (cash or check only)

\$10 team fee paid at packet pick-up (cash or check only)

## **Categories/Age Classes:**

**Solo Riders:** M&F under 40 and 40+

**2 and/or 3 Person Teams:** Male, Female, Coed

**3 Person Junior Teams:** 13-18

Age delineations for solo race categories were revised (from 35 year of age to 40 years of age) in an attempt to evenly distribute riders within the two age categories. The promoter reserves the right to revise the age categories should rider distribution be significantly unequal. The promoter reserves the right to combine age categories should one age category contain less than 10 riders.

## **Special Junior Race:**

Consists of one lap of the ST8 course starting 30 minutes (**9 AM**) before the ST8 Race. Categories M&F 13-14, 15-16, and 17-18.

Special entry fee: \$10 per racer, day of race registration only (6:30-8:30 AM). Junior riders must have parent of guardian sign the race waiver.

## **Awards and Prizes:**

Merchandise and (medals, certificates, or trophies) to top three finishers in each category.

### **Directions to Curt Gowdy State Park:**

From Cheyenne, WY take I-25 to exit 10 and travel 25 miles west on Highway 210, Happy Jack Road. From Laramie take I-80 east to exit 323 and travel east 14 miles on Highway 210. Follow signs at the park entrance on south side of Highway 210.

### **General Rules:**

1. Le Mans start;
2. All Riders must start their last lap no later than 5:00 PM (i.e., finish their next to last lap by 5:00 PM);
3. All Riders must complete at least one lap to have their laps and times count (i.e., not be declared “Did Not Finish” – DNF). Each rider from a team must complete at least one lap for their team to qualify. No one rider may have more than 2 laps more than any other rider on their team. No three person team may have two riders with 2 laps more than their third rider;
4. All Riders must stop at the scorer/timer table and have their number recorded each lap before proceeding to next lap or before handing off baton for their teammate can proceed;
5. Course cutting could result in disqualification of an individual or team (at the discretion of the race director and appointed race staff), at a minimum the lap will not count, but the time will. If you make a wrong turn or leave the course you must re-enter the course at that point to continue with a lap;
6. USAC rules pertaining to on course mechanical aid apply (i.e., not allowed by other riders). Aid can be supplied in the pit areas of the race;
7. The race is a rain/snow or shine event. However, the race director can cancel the race at anytime should the conditions become too dangerous to riders or detrimental to trails. If the race is cancelled or delayed after the race starts:
  - a. All racers which have already started a lap will be allowed to finish the lap. Their lap and time totals will be used to compute their standing; or
  - b. Racers may cancel a lap and their time/lap total at the beginning of the cancelled lap will be used to compute their standing;
  - c. If conditions allow for a restart prior to 5 PM, a second Le Mans start will be conducted with all racers starting at the same time.

8. Participants are subject to all state park rules (*including Chapter 1, Section 16(b)... no glass beverage containers allowed outside of vehicles*).
